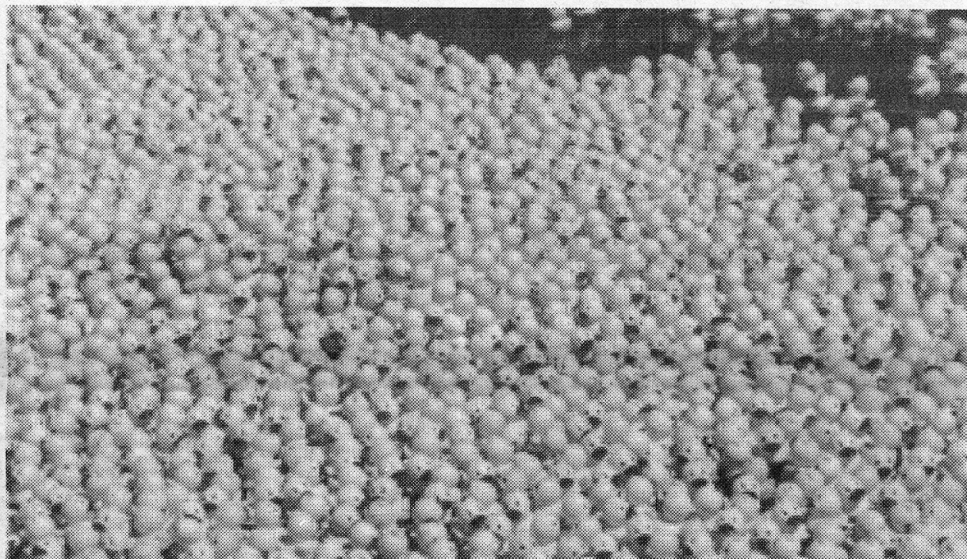

Photographs are nice, and should be accompanied by a caption and a photographer credit.

Letters that are more than 200 words may be published, but Arthur reserves the right to edit letters for length.

Contributors are strongly encouraged to attend story meeting on Fridays at 11:00 am or otherwise contact Arthur editors to discuss story ideas before submitting.
